


Egrets and Sunrise



Egrets At Sunrise was a composite of two captures taken early in the morning at the Merced National Wildlife Refuge. The egrets had been roosting at night in a nearby tree for at least a couple of days and this morning I found them again pre dawn in the tree. It was very foggy that morning and as it began to get a little lighter the egrets flew down from the tree to water below. The sun broke through the fog a few minutes after the egrets had left and I make a capture of the sun to composite with the egret photo. The egret exposure was taken with a Sony a7rii in manual mode with a Canon 600mm f/4 with a 1.4 converter for a 840mm focal length. 1/200s, f/8.0, ISO 800. The sun photo was with the Sony a7rii and the 600mm by itself. 1/500s, f/8.0, ISO 800.

Trees have always been a favorite subject of mine and this one seemed to stand out. I used my Sony A7R3 with a Nikkor 135mm 3.5 lens from the 1950s. Truly an outstanding and very heavy lens even 60 years on. This is a raw image converted to a DNG file and processed in Photoshop CS4 and printed on an Epson Surecolor P800.
