

Milky Way Over Half Dome

This is the second time I attempt Milky Way Over Half Dome this year. The first time was in early March. I got an over night permit for Glacier Point and prepared cross-country skiing to Glacier Point and backpacking on the snow. It was a good opportunity for sunset, sunrise and milky way photography. I built a snow sled to carry all overnight gears plus photography gears including two bodies, four lenses and two tripods. The snow condition was ok for skiing considering the end of skiing season, but my sled kept flipping and I had to stop and turn the sled to up right position again and again. For sure I could not reach Glacier point before sunset with this slow-moving speed. I had to quit and return. Hopefully, I could get a Milky Way over Glacier Point in snow next year.

When glacier point road reopened in early May. I drove to Glacier Point (This is much easier than cross county skiing) and capture this photo. From Planit app, the milky way starts to show up around 11:20 pm. This set of photos was taken around 11:27pm using Nikon D850 with Sigma 14mm f1.8 lens. Three panoramic photos in landscape orientation were taken. The setting was ISO 8000, 25 sec and f/1.8. Photos were merged in Lrc, denoised in Topez Denoise Ai, and fine-tuned in Viveza 2. I also used Sony a7r4 with Zeiss 18mm f2.8 lens to take another set of Milky Way, but too much noise compared to Nikon set.




Spring in Yosemite

Of course Yosemite is a favorite of most photographers, You see something different each time you visit






Beach Encounter

The bee is a golden northern bumble bee. I found two of them feeding on a penstemon bush. The image was taken with a 100 mm macro lens on a Canon 80D. This camera and lens combo I use almost exclusively for macro work. The bees move very fast and do not stay on the flowers very long. So it took a series of bursts to get a very few pictures that were worthwhile. The camera settings were ISO 800, f6.3, at 1000 of a second. The image was processed in Lightroom and sharpened in Topax.

PSA Galleries


PSA has several galleries on this website where members can share their photography with others.
