Field Trip: Yosemite Horsetail Falls

Sunday, February 17, 2013 was the Fresno Camera Club field trip to Yosemite. The prime time for photographing the phenomenon of golden orange sunset light reflecting on Horsetail falls and the granite walls adjacent, is mid February. We were there and we were prepared.

The throngs of photographers from around the world was an astonishing site to behold. We talked to people from Ohio, China, Monterey and England. Having set up our tripods about noon, we proceeded to eat barbeque hot dogs, potato salad and chips for our group of about fourteen. We then ate cake and vis-



ited, adjusted our cameras and waited, in anticipation, for five hours. It sounds like a long wait, but we made the best of it, and most said that they would do it again.



Elizabeth had the foresight to bring a propane heater, as it was cold and damp. Jonathan would still be there, cast in a frozen block of ice, had the heater not been available.

After visiting with the other photographers, the time came and as the sunlight hit the granite, shutters began their harmonious clicking, photographers frantically made multiple camera adjustments while simultaneously pushing the remote shutter releases in an effort to get as many shots as possible, before the light gave way to darkness.



As we exited a dark and cold Yosemite, we couldn't wait to get our cold and tired bodies home to our computers and immediately view the fruits of our labor. We went straight to bed, the images could wait until tomorrow.

The Garden Snail

The "**Garden Snail"** was photographed by Hanna Barsam in 1957 using his Hasselblad camera. It has won many awards and medals in competitions. It was hung in the Natural History Museum in Chicago.

Several years ago in 2001, Hanna received a phone call from Chicago. The caller asked, "Are you the H.S. Barsam, who photographed the Garden Snail that hangs in the Natural History Museum in Chicago?" Hanna said he was. The caller asked for permission to use this picture in a Math textbook for the Chicago City School system. They agreed on a price, and 44 years after the picture was taken he sold it for \$200.

The Snail was one of the three photos we displayed on the wall at the Fresno Fair in 2003.
