Despite the workshop in March, there were a number of issues with incorrect files sizes being entered, members are reminded that images should be no wider than 1400 pixels, and no taller than 1050. File names were also somewhat of an issue, and I would remind you not to use periods, commas or apostrophes in your file names other than the dot jpg at the end.

Aaron Rogers of Horn Photo was our judge for the

evening, he joined 7 of us for dinner at Old Spaghetti Factory, sharing some of his knowledge and answering questions on equipment as we dined. Aaron provided excellent critique on the images presented, awarding a total of 10 perfect 10's to the images judged. He then selected his 4 images for the best of the night.

Image of the Month went to Dr Ning Lin and his shot of Ibex Dunes Sunset. Pat

Fresno Camera Club Rhames took second place with Cycle of Life, with Jonathan Rollins grabbing 3<sup>rd</sup> with his shot of the Super Bloom at Carrizo National Monument. Dave Youngs took 4<sup>th</sup> place with his creative piece, Vienna Square, which he told us was an exercise in math and Trigonometry!


**Ibex Dunes at Sunset**

Ibex Dunes are very photographable although they are smaller than other dunes in Death Valley. We went to Death Valley in the weekend of March 17 to photograph the wildflowers in Death Valley. The wildflowers in front of the Ibex Dunes were still blooming. When the sun was setting, the clouds turned to flame-like shape and color. I used Canon 1Dx mark ii with 16-35mm lens to catch this moment. Focal length: 21mm, ISO: 100, S: 1.6s, F: 16, EV: 0.33, Filter: GND. The image was processed with LR.







Cycle of Life

This image was taken on Land Conservancy property outside of Mariposa, toward Yosemite. David Hunter is the Conservancy photographer and he dragged me along on one of his shoots for them. This was February 19th of this year.

As you may recall, we were experiencing a rather wet Winter and we wanted to shoot waterfalls, among other things.

As we started into the property, David leaving me in his dust, as usual, discovered the skull in this image in the very position that it was photographed. We both felt it would make an interesting image, and we both photographed it. I got very low, on my belly, just above ground level and actually shot a little up from there. No tripod was used in this case.

I have rendered this image in both monochrome and color and think they are both strong. The monochrome has a stronger visual impact.

I shot this this using my trusty Nikon D800E, with a Nikkor 24-70mm, f/2.8. The focal length was 56mm and the aperture was f/8.0. I focused on the skull itself and let everything behind it go out of focus.

Post processing was done, in this order, Lightroom for RAW adjustments, PhotoShop for enhancements and the application of some of the NIK modules.







Super Bloom at Carrizo National Monument

I was there two years ago and there was not a photographer in sight. Not so on this day, photographers were everywhere!

Nikon D800E, 36.3 megs, carbon fiber tripod, Really Right Stuff ball head, and shot at 200 ISO.







Vienna Square

This image started with a shot of a light show illuminating the Rathaus--Vienna's city hall.

Canon 5 D with 24-105 IS lens at 24mm, f 4.0 1/6 second handheld with IS on



This shot was opened in Photoshop and the polygonal lasso tool was used to select a right triangle with two 45 degree angles with the two legs measuring 6 inches.

This "seed" triangle was copied and pasted into a new document--a square with sides of 12 inches.

Now, imagine this square being cut in half horizontally, vertically, and along both diagonals. The square would be cut into 8 pieces--each the size of the seed triangle. Instead of cutting the square up, the square is built up triangle by triangle (each pasted on its own layer). The transform function in the Edit menu is used to move, flip, and or rotate each triangle into place to create the final image. If done correctly a beautiful image with four-fold symmetry is created.






