

This photo was taken from Woodward lake when I was kayaking. In order to get motion effect with clear head/eye in the image, I have tried different speed from 1/60 to 1/200. The successful rate to get a good image is very low. Lucky enough, I could capture this one during sunset with golden light. Canon R5, Canon 400mm/f4 lens with 1.4X Extender III (560mm), Canon EF to RF adapter. f/5.6, 125 sec, ISO 320, -0.3 step. Handheld (sitting in kayak)

The image was taken with an Olympus OM-D, Mark II mirror less camera and processed in Lightroom and Photoshop.





PSA has a **Personalized Image Evaluation Service**. This service is especially helpful if the maker wants to have his/her skills evaluated, if the maker would like to know what constitutes an acceptable image in one of the PSA Divisions, or for previewing Images before entering them in club competition or a PSA recognized Exhibition.

PSA also has an **Image Analysis Course**, which is helpful in judging ones own photos or becoming a certified judge.

PSA Galleries


PSA has several galleries on this website where members can share their photography with others.
