This is one of many images captured at the Merced Wildlife Preserve. The attraction of the scene, for me, was the moodiness of the foggy conditions, soft light and the silhouetted trees in the background. Equipment used was a Nikon D850 with a Nikkor 300mm, f/2.8, hand held. Settings were 1/2000 at f/2.8, exposure bias 1 EV, ISO 1250 and of course focal length 300mm. Exposure program was manual and metering was Matrix.

Post processing consisted of using DxO Photolab to clean up the fog related noise with artistic adjustments completed in Photoshop and NIK software

#### "ADVANTAGES OF HAVING PSA MEMBERSHIP

PSA has a **Personalized Image Evaluation Service**. This service is especially helpful if the maker wants to have his/her skills evaluated, if the maker would like to know what constitutes an acceptable image in one of the PSA Divisions, or for previewing Images before entering them in club competition or a PSA recognized Exhibition.

PSA also has an **Image Analysis Course**, which is helpful in judging ones own photos or becoming a certified judge.
