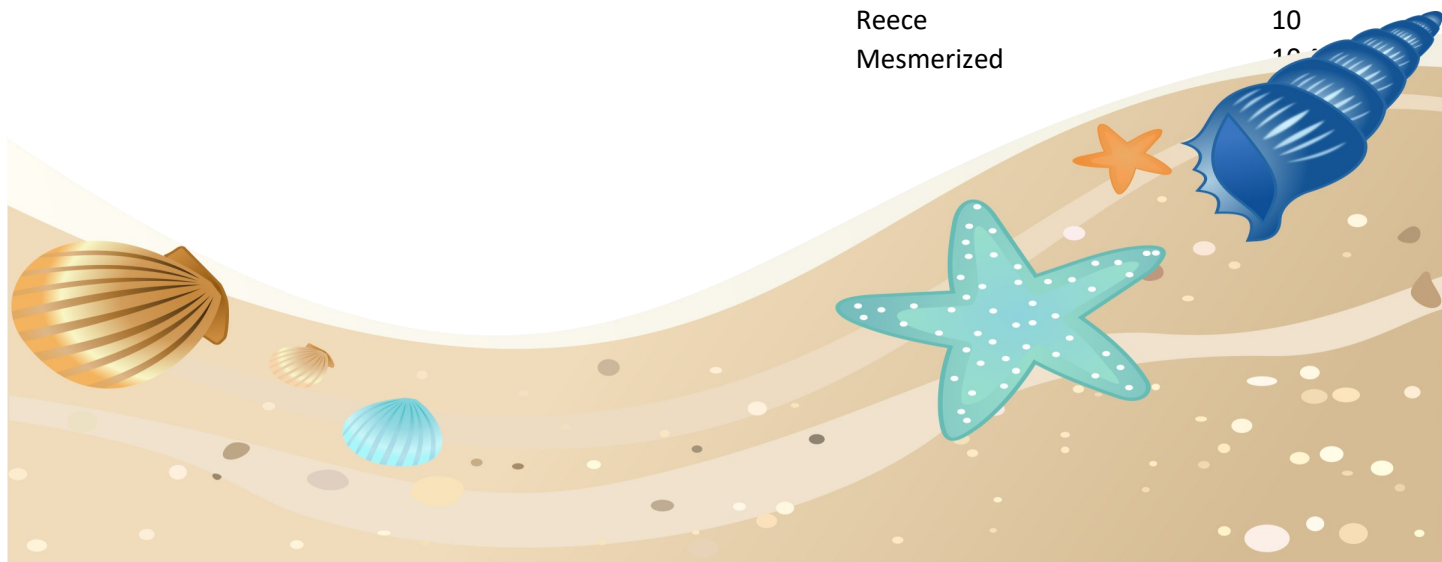

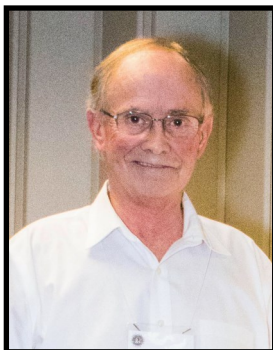

Coastal Trees

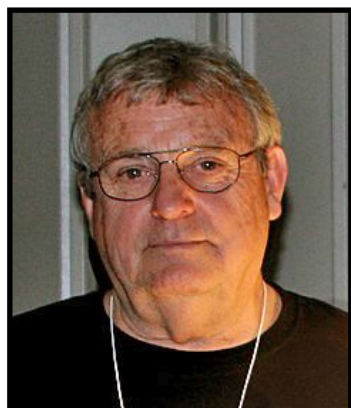

Coastal Trees: This shot was taken over on the coast near San Simeon just off Highway 1. I had driven by this location on several occasions looking for the right atmosphere. This particular morning had the atmospheric conditions I was looking for and had the added extra bonus of the horses in the trees. This was a focus stack with the originals coming from my Fuji GFX 100 and a gf 45-100mm lens at 100mm. F/11, ISO 100, 1/30s.

Lee Vining Fallscape

On October 24, 2019, Jim (Frogman) Sanderson, Jon (Popcorn Girl) Rollins and I travelled over to the East side of the Sierras to shoot the Fall color, in progress at the time.

By midafternoon, we were descending from Tioga summit into the Lee Vining Creek Drainage, not far from the burg of Lee Vining, itself. As we reached lower elevation, we observed the Spruce and Alder along side the creek in full Autumn splendor. We decided to stop and shoot.

This shot is toward the West, which includes the Sun (obviously). Particularly because of that circumstance, I bracketed nine exposures, one f/stop apart, under to over exposed. The equipment used included my trusty Nikon D850 and Nikkor 14-24mm f/2.8 lens, mounted on a sturdy tripod. No filter was used.

Settings were as follows: aperture f/16, manual exposure, matrix metering mode, ISO 64, focal distance 14mm. Bracketing was accomplished with shutter speed variation.

Post was begun in Lightroom for RAW, then to Photoshop and NIK for finishing. NIK HDR Efex 2 was used to merge the nine exposures and render the HDR composited.

Printing was done on an Epson SureColor P9570 wide format printer on Epson Metallic Photo Paper Glossy to give the image a deep, vibrant "liquid" look.

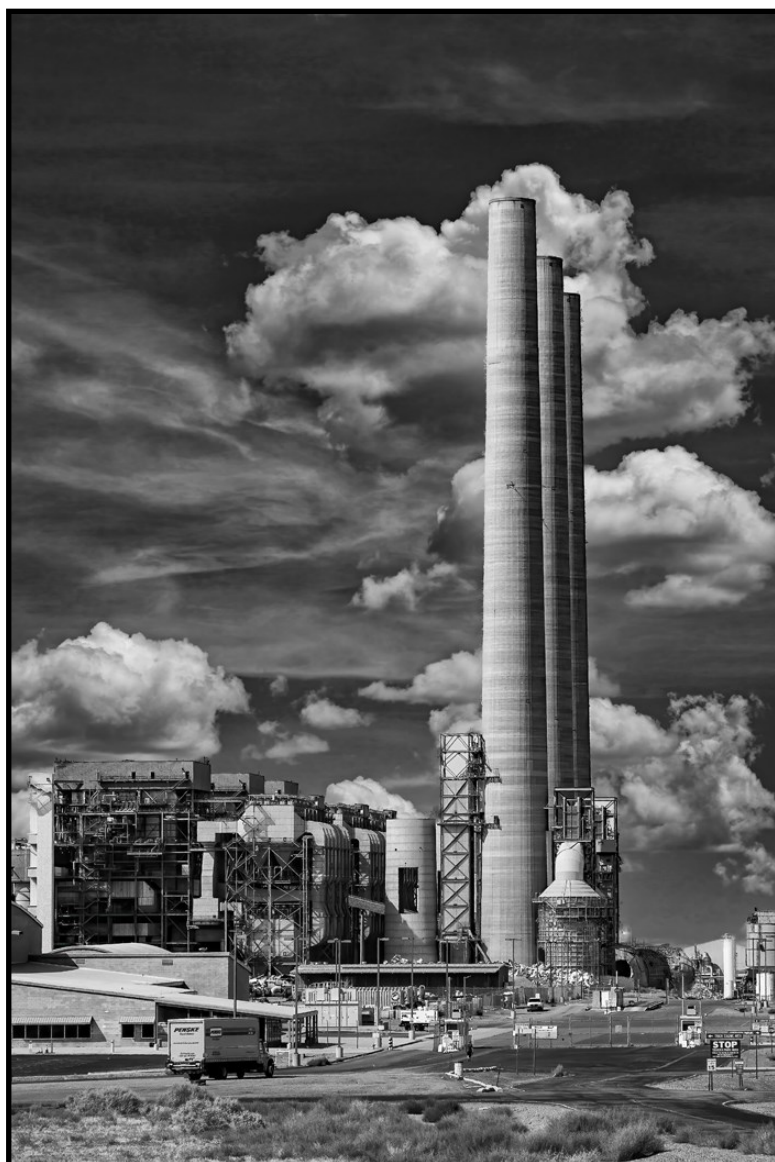

Mac has been dancing for 13 years and I've entered several of her dance poses. She's been an excellent model and you'll probably be seeing more of her in the coming year because she's obviously my favorite subject!

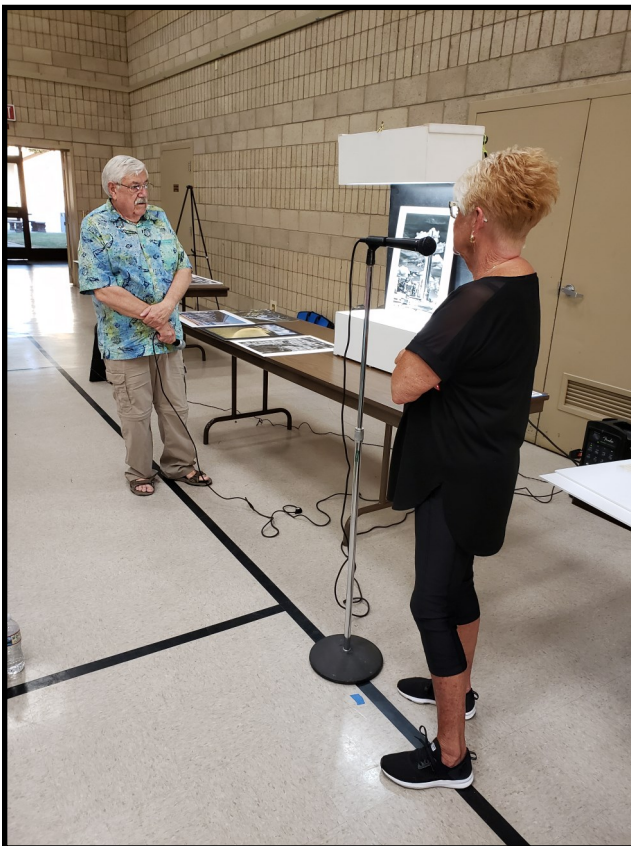
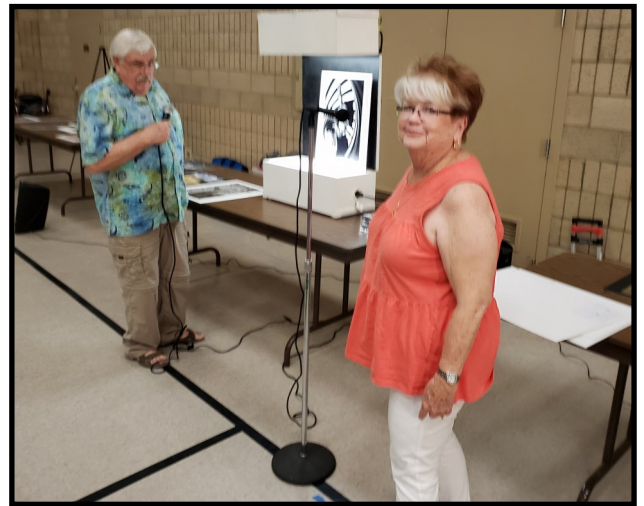

Each State, Province, or Country may contain individual member galleries that showcase members' work. Individual images and bios in galleries may be updated by members as often as they would like. A list of available galleries is accessed from the left pane of this webpage, grouped according to PSA Member Area. They can also be accessed from a state/province/country and some chapter pages on the site.

Each PSA member can create a gallery of up to 6 images and a biography with a link to a personal web gallery. **Member galleries stay on the PSA site for as long as a member remains a PSA member in good standing.**

"ADVANTAGES OF HAVING PSA MEMBERSHIP

PSA has a **Personalized Image Evaluation Service**. This service is especially helpful if the maker wants to have his/her skills evaluated, if the maker would like to know what constitutes an acceptable image in one of the PSA Divisions, or for pre-viewing Images before entering them in club competition or a PSA recognized Exhibition.

PSA also has an **Image Analysis Course**, which is helpful in judging ones own photos or becoming a certified judge.

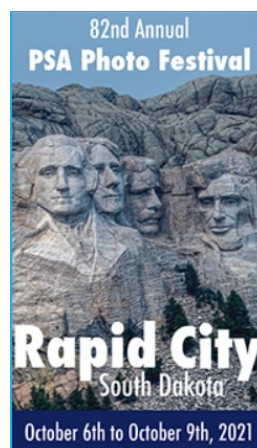
