




Getting Around the Barrel by Heide Stover

PASSINGS—DAVID MEISENHEIMER, FPSA, GMPSA

David Meisenheimer of Grand Junction, CO will surely be missed, but never forgotten.

David was diagnosed with Bone Marrow Leukemia on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019 and he fought the battle with several rounds of chemo for eight (8) months. In the beginning the chemo was on David's side, but by round three and four everything turned around and he was given six (6) months to live. He continued his passion of photography for as long as he could until the end because other than the love for his wife his only real love was photography. He passed away on 6/20/20 at about 10:30 pm to join his first love, Carol. He was able to see all of his children the day before and his passing was peaceful.



David was always interested in photography while growing up, but of course knew nothing about it nor could he afford the cost. In fact, he did not know the difference between shutter speed and aperture. He got hooked into photography after taking a local photo class that included a photo contest of which he had won an Honorable Mention. David and his wife joined the ACES Camera Club in Anaheim, CA in 1986. He entered the local competition and had some luck. The ACES belonged to the S4C Council of Camera Clubs in the Los Angeles, CA. area & eventually he started entering their monthly competitions. Eventually he took on various jobs with the ACES including Vice President, President, Judge Chairman, etc. As he got more involved in photography, he and his wife Carol took on several jobs with S4C including Chairmen of the annual S4C PSA Exhibitions in several divisions and also, they were Director of the monthly S4C competitions. One thing leads to another and so both David and Carol eventually were Co-Vice Chairmen of the PSA Southern CA Roundup Chapter taking on different functions. After doing that for 2 years David became the Chairman of the PSA Southern CA Roundup Chapter, but he was only in that position for a short time because his wife Carol and he moved to Colorado in 2003 where they joined the Pikes Peak Camera Club and of course took on several jobs there. David became the Vice President and then took over the judge chairmanship.

David never thought that he would ever earn a PSA Honor until one day he got a call from Pat Boquist from the Circle of Confusion Camera Club in Whittier, CA asking if he would consider taking on a Directorship at the PSA Southern CA Roundup Chapter. For this she offered to sponsor him for APSA the following year. After talking it over with Carol he decided to accept Pat's offer, but only if Carol and he could be Vice-Chairs at the Sheraton Hotel for the twice annual Roundups so that Carol could also apply for her APSA. Carol took on the menu for the luncheons and David was the Vice-Chairman for arranging rooms for the guest speakers. Note that they did everything together.

David became the Director of PSA Nature Who's Who for the Nature Division in 2003 for five years. Starting in 2006 David took the job of PSA Nature Image Evaluator for New Members which eventually was

changed to anyone could submit Nature images for evaluation. He held that position for 14 years and had to resign in March 2020 due to him losing the battle to leukemia.

David was in the Top 25 listings in Who's Who PSA Nature for six (6) straight years from 2001 thru 2006. He also was in the Top 25 in Who's Who PJ in 2006 and 2011 and in the Top 25 in Who's Who PT in 2001, 2002, 2004 and 2010.

David and Carol enjoyed judging many dozens of times (Together) over the years at many Southern California Camera Clubs and at Twenty-Two (22) PSA International competitions.

David and Carol led three (3) tours to Kenya and Tanzania, Africa for PSA'ers and performed many slide shows all over Southern, CA for many years.

David earned his APSA in 2002 and FPSA in 2008.

David had slides submitted to TOP's in Photography and had calls by invitation to submit slides for the permanent collection. David had a number of publications in the newspaper, articles, booklets from winning various competitions. Also, David and Carol were asked to submit slides for the PSA Journal Distinctive Image Series in 2013.

David was also very proficient in winning many medals and HM's in local and in PSA Internationals. He earned Galaxy 9 in CS, Galaxy 9 in NS, Galaxy 6 in PT and Galaxy 4 in PJ. David earned his MPSA and GMPSA both in June of 2011. David continued pursuing acceptances for the next GMPSA level, but his illness prevented getting to the next level. His secret to success was listening to the judges' comments and then applying what he had learned and he could not stress this enough to listen, practice and learn!!!!
